## Universidad Católica de Colombia is part of the QS World University Rankings 2025



In this new edition, the University is ranked among the top 20 higher education institutions nationwide and the top 10 in Bogotá.

For the fourth consecutive year, the Universidad Católica de Colombia has been included in the QS World University Ranking, which assesses higher education institutions globally based on factors such as research, employability, academic experience, global engagement, and sustainability, among others.

This year, the University improved its rating in the international network's indicator,

reflecting the positive impact of its efforts to build sustainable research partnerships with both national and international collaborators.

Research has been highlighted as a key strength in this ranking, with a 7% increase in the indicator for citations per professor in the fields of Social and Administrative Sciences, Arts and Humanities, and Engineering and Technology. This growth demonstrates the significant impact of the University's publications.

We extend our gratitude to the entire university community and encourage them to maintain their commitment and dedication. Together, let us continue advancing our person-centered educational project, aligned with the evolving challenges of education and focused on creating spaces for dialogue that contribute to the social development of the country.

#### Universidad Católica de Colombia once again ranked in the Impact Ranking of Times Higher Education



The Universidad Católica de Colombia has received notable recognition in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Ranking for the second consecutive year. In this edition, the University is ranked between 801-1000 out of 1,591 institutions worldwide.

The University has demonstrated its commitment to and progress in 16 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), with particular distinction in SDG 16, which focuses on Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions. In this area, the University ranks among the top 300 universities globally.



# Furthermore, the University has achieved impressive results in key areas such as:

- Decent Work and Economic Growth (SDG 8)
- Good Health and Well-being (SDG 3)

The Universidad Católica de Colombia has also improved its performance in the following areas compared to the previous edition:

- Reducing Inequalities (SDG 10)
- Responsible Production and Consumption (SDG 12)
- Life Below Water (SDG 14)
- Climate Action (SDG 13)
- Life on Land (SDG 15)

Nationally, the University is among the top five institutions in the ranking, alongside Universidad de Los Andes, Universidad de La Salle, and Universidad de la Costa. This ranking underscores the University's commitment to sustainable development in Colombia.

These achievements are attributed to the University's effective governance model, which promotes the involvement of the academic community in decision-making and collaboration with local stakeholders. The Law School's specialized advice to public institutions and the management of diverse research projects also contribute to these results.

In education, the University has enhanced access to basic services within communities, promoted entrepreneurship programs, and committed to training health workers, particularly in psychology. It has also undertaken initiatives to improve mental and physical health within both its internal and local communities.

Our University is proud of its exceptional standing in the Times Higher Education Impact Ranking and reaffirms its dedication to sustainable development, quality education, and the formation of partnerships to achieve the SDGs.
